Subject: California Proposition 65 (effective May 25, 2018)

This letter is to inform our Ascend Performance Materials customers that, with the exception of the products listed below, chemicals listed on California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 are not intentionally added or used in the manufacture of any Vydyne or Ascend product. This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65 (Prop.65), establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
